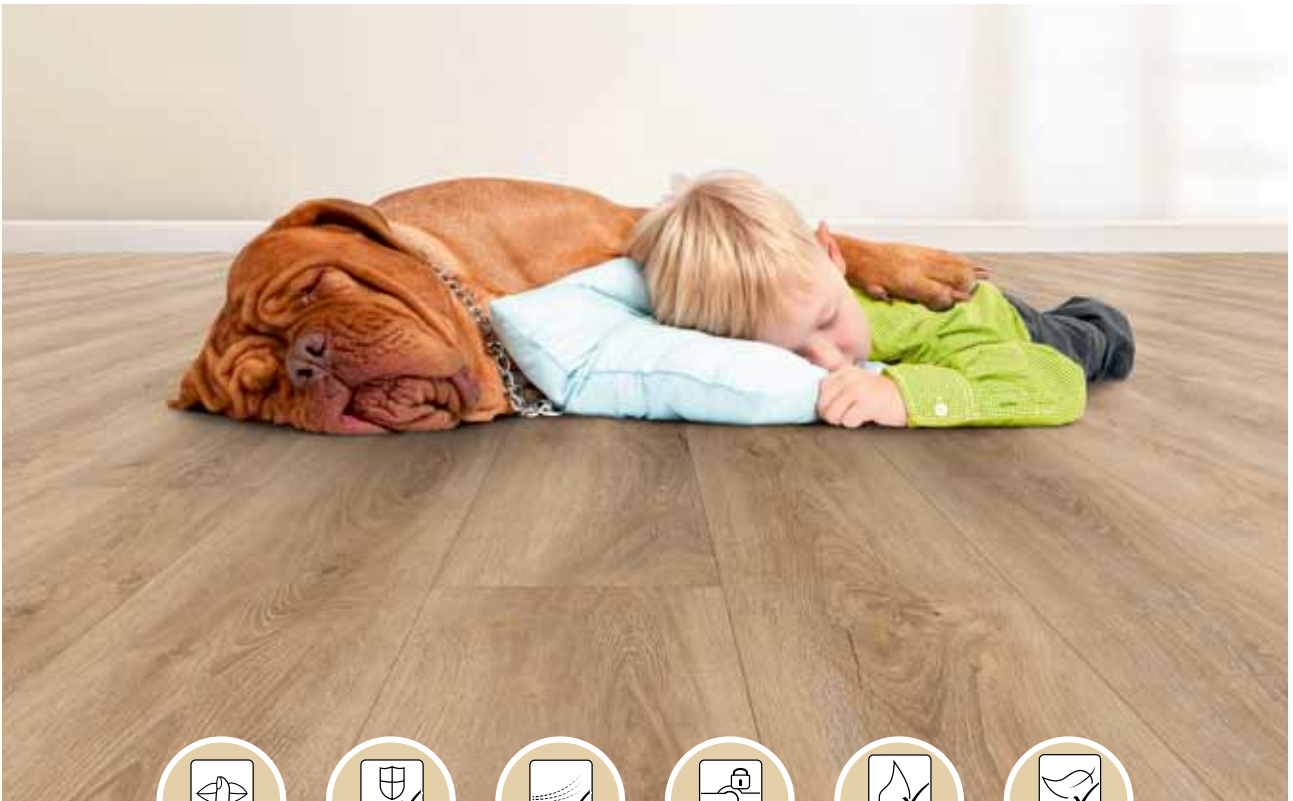

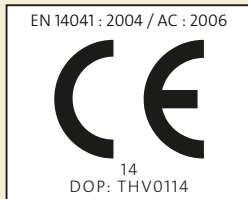

CONFIRMATION OF CERTIFICATES – LUXURY VINYL TILES

We hereby confirm that our Luxury Vinyl Tiles have been awarded the following certificates:



The CE Certificate

This certifies the conformity of our Luxury Vinyl Tiles with the requirements of EN 14041. This norm encompasses all floor coverings for internal use. The application of building products in the European market is governed by the European Building Products Regulations. The building products, which fulfill the requirements as set down in the technical specifications, may carry the CE mark. The CE mark must contain a DOP No. (Declaration of Performance), which links it to the CE declaration of performance. The CE mark must be shown on the product (above the label or product insert).



The Ü mark

The conformity mark identifies building products, which conform to the building inspection technical regulations, the building inspection authorization, the building inspection test certificates or have been individually confirmed. The conformity certificate is issued by the German Institute for Building Technology (DiBt). The emission regulations for compliance with the Ü mark are known to be the strictest world-wide. The Ü mark designates products, which have fulfilled these specifications. The mark bearing the licence number is issued by the DiBt. Under the terms of a surveillance contract, this institute tests the vinyl floor from the production line once a year for compliance with the approved product.

The A+ mark

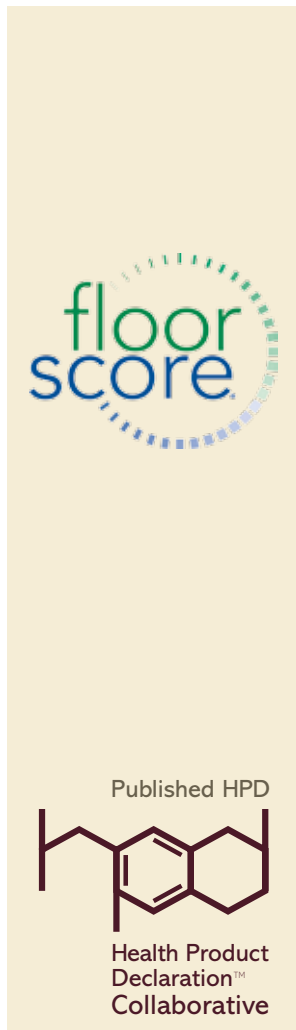
From 1 January 2012 any new building and outfitting products, brought into the French market must be classified and marked according to their emissions. Decree no. 2011-321" published on 24 March 2011 declared this.

Products which already exist in the French market are governed by the emissions classification and labelling regulations from 1 September 2013. This identification is in addition to the CE mark (if required for the product in question). The French emissions regulations require imperatively that building products are labelled. Different from Germany also worse products, i.e. emissions classes C, B & A are allowed. It is expected, however that the end user selects the best product. Our product is classified in Class A+.

The American Floor Score Certificate

Floor Score is a prerequisite for products to be included in LEED projects, currently world-wide the most used evaluation system for building projects.

Indoor air quality: in order to qualify for the Floor Score Label for floor coverings, the product must pass demanding emissions tests, which guarantee that the product has no emissions that harm the indoor air quality. Further the certification requires regular factory audits.

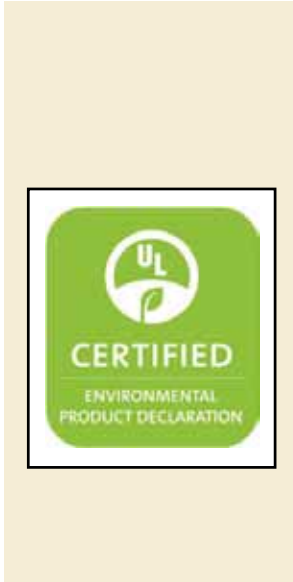
The Floor Score Label fulfills the requirements of the renowned international LEED certification for the criteria :indoor air quality. The Floor Score Label for floor covering materials is issued by the US American Resilient Floor Covering Institute (RFCI). The LEED certification for building is based on the commonly used U.S. Green Building Council evaluation criteria and the certificate issued by the latter. The LEED certificate is only issued for buildings, not for building products (see Floor Score). The building is thoroughly evaluated according to its impact on the environment of its location, its water consumption, its energy-efficiency, its use of materials and the conditions inside. There are four levels in the LEED certification. The number of points which a project is given, determine the level of the LEED certification (Certified: 40-49 points, Silver: 50-59 points, Gold: 60-79 points, Platinum: 80-110 points).

HPD, Health Product Declaration

The health product declaration (hpd) is the complete listing of the possibly harmful chemicals in products. The breakdown of the contents is mandatory in the latest version LEED v4.




Environmental product declaration

The EPD is an comprehensive diagnosis of the life cycle, from acquisition of the raw material to recycling at the end of the life cycle. This is analyzed following ISO 14025. The environmental product declaration offers the relevant information to enable sales and marketing to present the environmental characteristic. Our vinyl floor is assessed by the program of the German Institute for Construction and the Environment and certified by an independent laboratory.

Ecological balance, life cycle: An Environmental Product Declaration (EPD) is a Type III Environmental Declaration. This provides quantified environmental data on the life cycle of a product or service, to enable comparisons between products or services with the same function. An EPD is based on independently tested data from LCA (life cycle assessments), inventory analysis or information modules, which conform to the ISIO 14040 series of norms and can also contain additional information.
